Information (Answers 9 questions accurately) 45%	Completely answers all questions with accurate detail and includes 3 or more relevant facts. 45% x 40 = 18	Completely answers all questions with accurate detail and 1-2 relevant facts. 45% x 30 = 13.5	Answers 7-8 questions accurately or may leave out some important details. May or may not include relevant facts. 45% x 20 = 9	Answers less than 7 questions accurately. Many errors are evident in presentation. 45% x 10 = 4.5
Creativity (Props & costume) 25%	Appropriate costume is self-created. Includes 2 or more props to accurately represent character. 25% x 40 = 10	Appropriate costume is self-created. Includes 1 prop to accurately represent character. 25% x 30 = 7.5	Uses prop but no costume or costume without prop. Costume may not be appropriate or is not self created. 25% x 20 = 5	No costume or prop. Costume may be inappropriate. 25% x 10 = 2.5
Expression & Conventions 20%	Speaks slowly and clearly with expression; stopping, pausing, and raising & lowering voice when appropriate. 20% x 40 = 8	Speaks clearly and is easy to understand. Uses some pauses and expression in voice. 20% x 30 = 6	Speaks clearly but may rush or voice is quiet and difficult to hear. May lack expression. 20% x 20 = 4	Rushes through presentation, difficult to hear, monotone voice. Too quiet. 20% x 10 = 2
Posture & Eye Contact (with audience) 10%	Faces audience, stands up straight, appears confident. Establishes eye contact 90%-100% of time. Does not use note cards. 10% x 40 = 4	Faces audience, stands up straight. Establishes eye contact 50%-80% of the time. May or may not use note cards. 10% x 30 = 3	Does not face audience. Reads from notecards. Makes eye contact less than 50% of the time. 10% x 20 = 2	Reads entire presentation and does not make eye contact. 10% x 10 = 1
