Project Details

In this research project, students will research their chosen god or goddess from Greek Mythology. They may use the handouts from the teacher, minibooks, resources from the library, and websites. Additionally, students are highly encouraged to dress up and use props to add to their presentation.

The majority of the research will be done in school. Students are required to provide detailed answers to all questions asked by the teacher. Once students have answered all questions in the packet, they will type their oral presentation in GoogleDocs. (Students have been given a username and password in school already.) All work MUST be shared with the teacher.
